## HIGHLIGHTS



Shree Venkateshwara Hi-Tech Engineering College was established in 2008 with 183 students. At present, the institution includes Engineering, Polytechnic, Paramedical, Nursing, Arts & Science colleges, and schools, with a total strength of 13,000+ students.



Around 2,400 boys and girls are accommodated in the institution's integrated hostel facilities.



For the convenience of students and staff, 125 college/school buses operate within a radius of nearly 100 km.



The Engineering College is approved by AICTE and affiliated with Anna University.



The college has been granted Autonomous status by UGC, New Delhi.



The institution has secured NAAC "A" Grade accreditation.



NBA accreditation has been obtained for departments such as Civil, CSE, ECE, EEE, and Mechanical Engineering.



The institution is certified with ISO 9001:2015 standards.



Through the Training and Placement Cell, more than 95% of students secure placements every year and are working in various sectors.



More than 4,075 students have successfully completed their studies and secured employment opportunities. Students have been placed in leading software companies such as TCS, Wipro, Rincex, Infosys, and Hexaware with annual salary packages ranging from 6 to 15 lakhs.



Students recruited through campus interviews are working efficiently with salary packages ranging from 3 to 5 lakhs per annum.



Alumni of the institution are employed in countries such as Malaysia, Singapore, Oman, Qatar, and Abu Dhabi, earning annual salaries ranging from 12 to 14 lakhs in reputed positions.



Former students are also serving as lecturers in Polytechnic and Engineering Colleges.



Engineering graduates from the institution pursue higher education in countries such as London, Germany, Switzerland, and Thailand, and are employed both abroad and in India.



Students selected through competitive examinations are serving as Government employees.



Alumni are contributing to society by creating employment opportunities and promoting technological development.
